For anyone over 18 we have groups on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays making crafts, learning to cook and just having a chat.

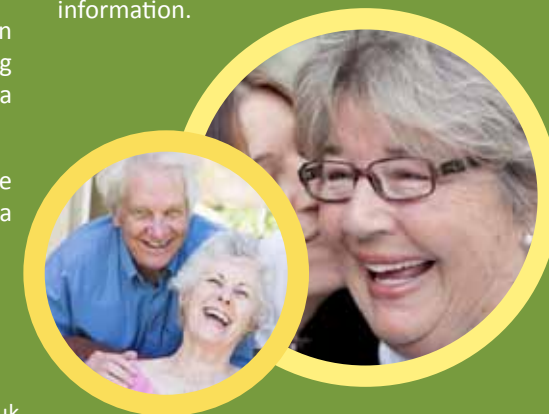
For everybody and anybody we have the Footprints breakfast morning on a Tuesday.
